1. Your membership is based on your contribution, work, and your behavior.
 - It is important to be active and productive member of ASB; meet deadlines, attend all ASB meetings, work ASB lunch activities, student store, as well as participate in all ASB dances, functions, and fundraisers.
2. Professionalism is important. You are the leaders at the school; act accordingly!
 - Work comes before fun.
 - Positive and respectful attitudes are key aspects to having a productive ASB.
 - Follow through on assigned responsibilities in a timely manner is extremely vital to maintaining a successful ASB
Take the initiative to assist club members with work or discover things to do for ASB when not busy.
3. Being in ASB is a privilege and a responsibility. As an ASB member, you have freedom and access to information not available to others; DO NOT abuse this privilege!
 - Business conducted in ASB meetings is expected to remain in ASB (meetings, voting, planning, problems, etc.)
 - With Freedom comes responsibility – please remember that and do not abuse your freedoms that come with ASB.
4. ASB members shall meet the following requirements to continue in ASB. Failure to meet these requirements will result in automatic removal from ASB:
 - ASB members shall not receive 3 or more of a combination of detentions or lunch detentions.
 - ASB members shall not receive a suspension – either in school (ACP) or out of school.
 - ASB members shall not be involved in plagiarism/cheating of any kind (including homework and forging signatures).
 - ASB members shall maintain a minimum of a 3.0 GPA and have **no F or D grades** on any report card or progress report in any class.
 - ASB members shall not receive any N or U citizenship grades on any report card or progress report.
 - ASB members shall not be assigned “ZAP” more than twice per quarter.
 - ASB members shall not be excessively absent from school to where it negatively affects their work or deadlines.
 - ASB members shall not miss more than two scheduled ASB meetings per semester (for any reason including, but not limited to, illness, personal necessity, involvement in other extra-curricular activities, work).
 - ASB members shall **participate in all ASB functions, fundraisers, dress up days (including ASB shirt day), as well as setup and clean up at all dances.**
 - ASB members shall adequately perform individual and group jobs and meet all deadlines.
 - ASB members shall not miss any job/activity for which they sign up or have been assigned to work (including Bobcat Cave).
 - ASB members shall not act disruptive, disrespectful, or defiant to any school staff member.
 - ASB members shall not be rude or act inappropriately towards any student when acting in ASB capacity.
 - ASB members shall refrain from eating, drinking, using cell phones, grooming, letter writing, side conversations, etc., while conducting ASB business.
 - ASB members shall not abuse the freedoms that come with being a member of ASB in any way.
 - ASB members shall not violate ASB confidentiality in any way.
 - ASB members shall work as a team and not isolate themselves in any manner or cause undue disruptions or tension within the club.
 - ASB members shall maintain a positive, cooperative, and respectful attitude during all ASB events and activities.
 - ASB members shall complete 15 hours of community service per semester (outside of normal ASB responsibilities).
