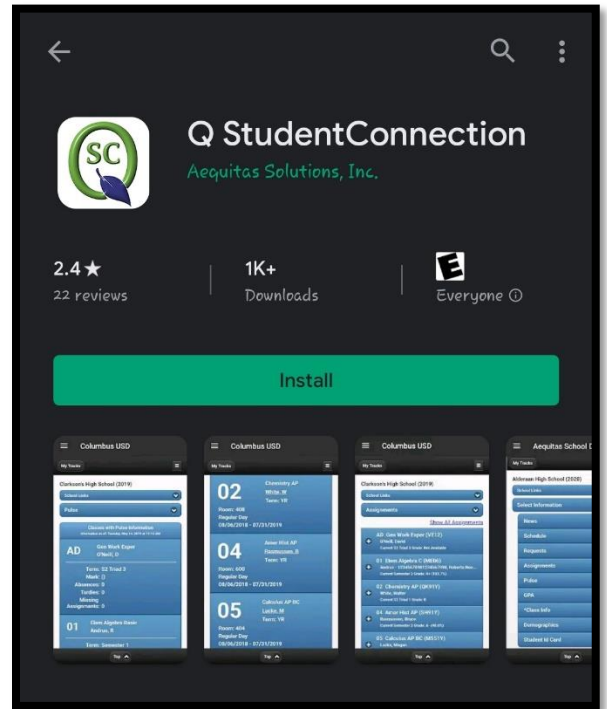

# HOW TO DOWNLOAD THE APP

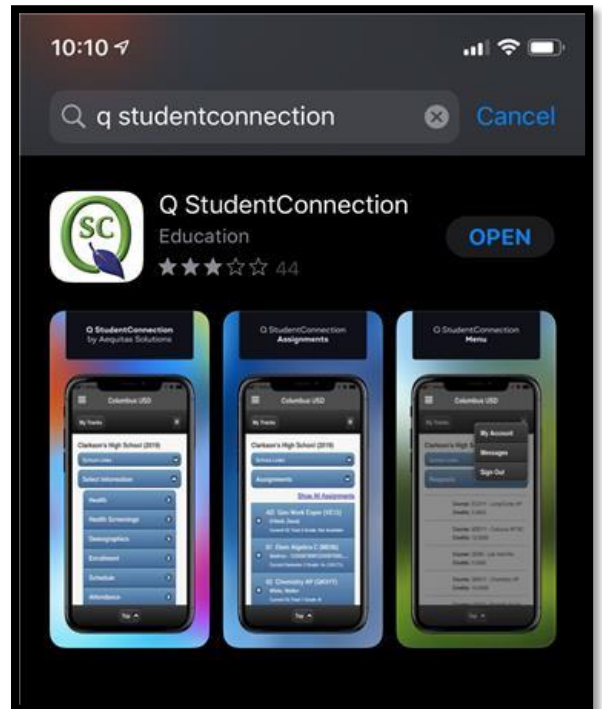
## 1) ANDRIOD

- ✓ In your App Store, search for **Q Student Connection**
- ✓ Select the icon and select **INSTALL**



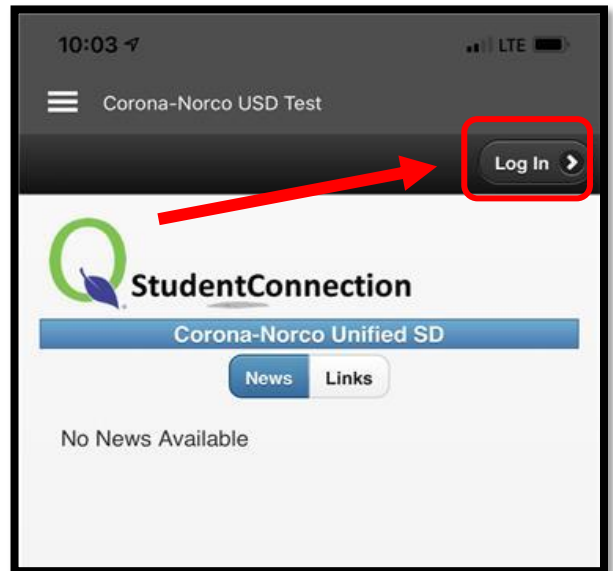
## 2) IOS

- ✓ In your App Store, search for **Q Student Connection**
- ✓ Select the icon and select **GET**

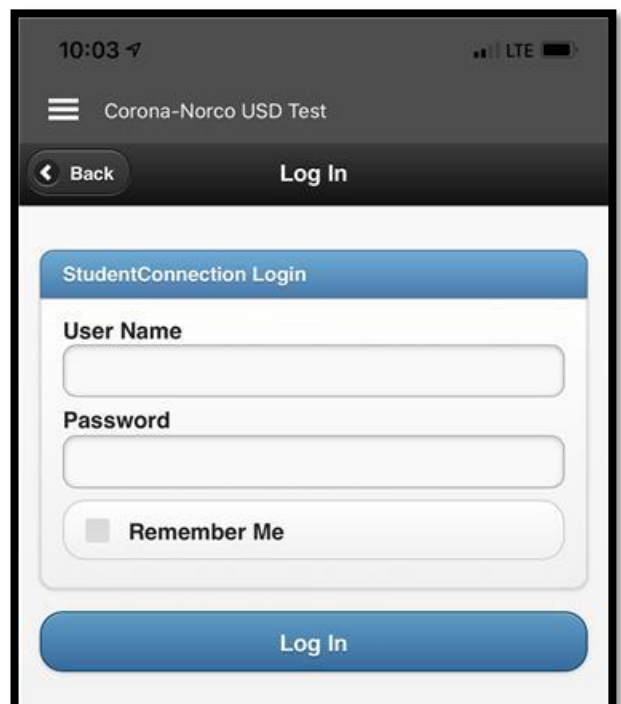


# HOW TO LOG ON TO Q STUDENT CONNECTION APP

- 1) **Launch** the app from your mobile device
- 2) Select the **LOG IN button** (upper right-hand corner)

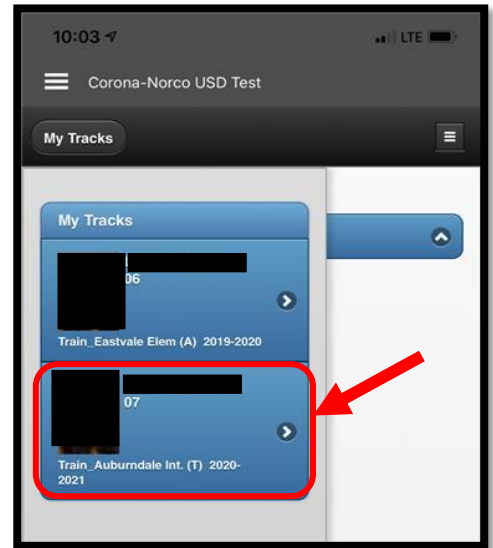


- 3) Enter your **Username/Password**
  - ✓ Username = Student ID #
  - ✓ Password = Same as what you use to log into the computer at school
- 4) Select **LOG IN**

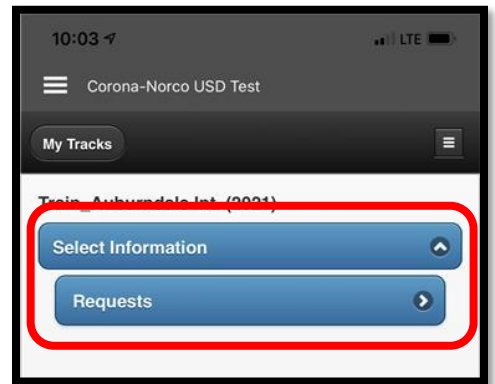


# HOW TO ADD COURSE REQUESTS

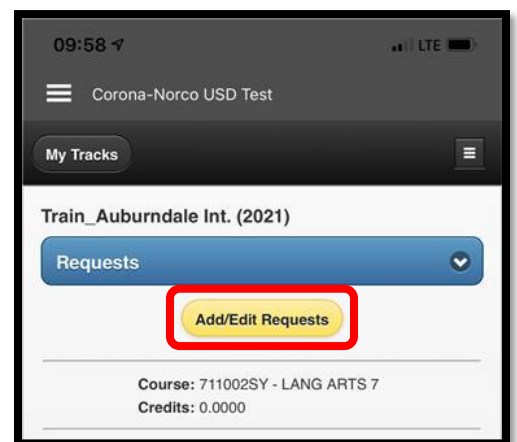
1) Select the **FUTURE YEAR** track/enrollment line



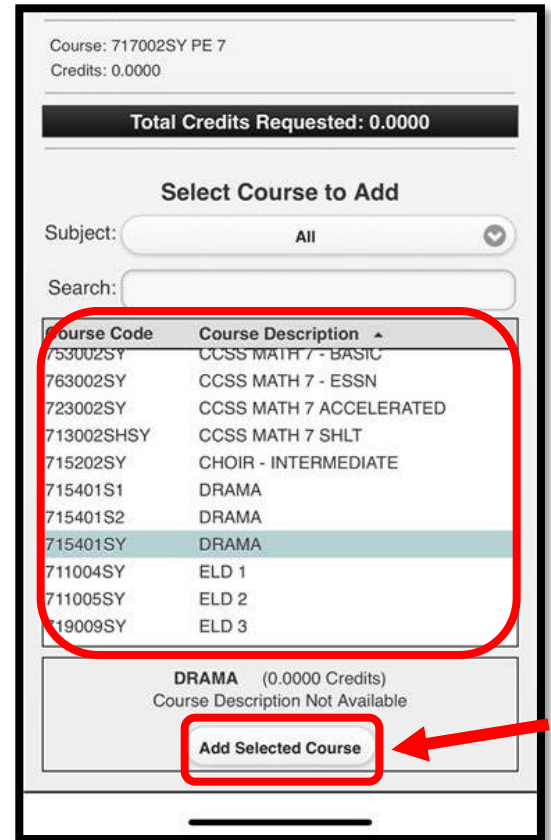
2) From the drop down, select **REQUESTS**



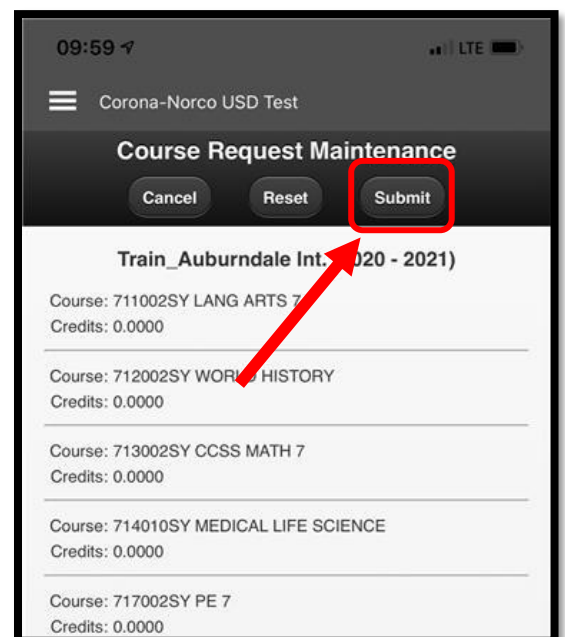
3) Select **ADD/EDIT REQUESTS** button



- 4) Search/Filter to find the **COURSE** you wish to ADD
- 5) **Select/Highlight** the course
- 6) Select the **ADD SELECTED COURSE** button
- 7) Repeat steps 4-6 until **all course requests have been selected**

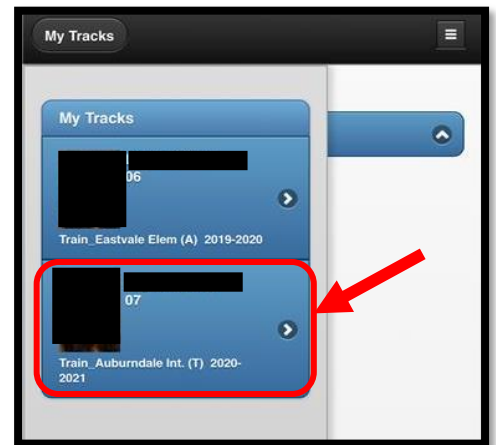


- 8) When finished select the **SUBMIT** button at the top of the screen

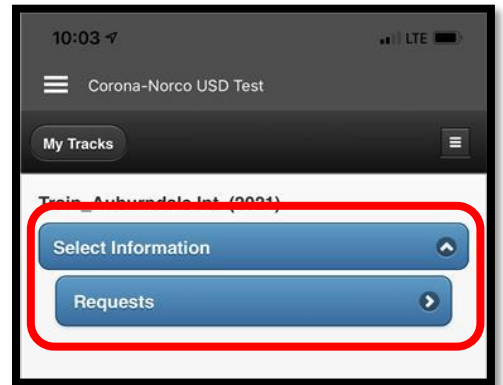


# HOW TO REMOVE A COURSE REQUEST

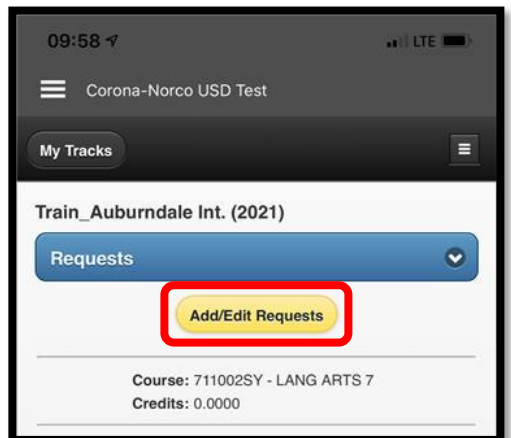
1) Select the **FUTURE YEAR** track/enrollment line



2) From the drop down, select **REQUESTS**



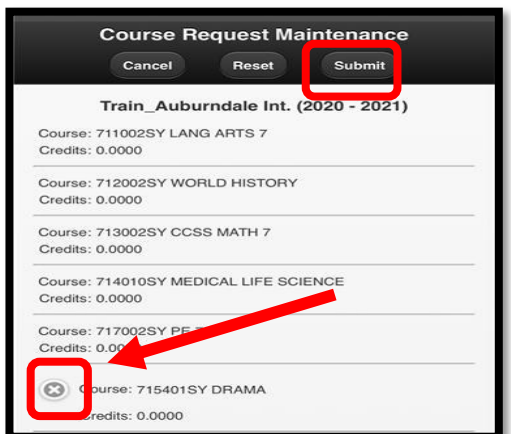
3) Select **ADD/EDIT REQUESTS** button



4) Select the **[X]** next to the course you want to remove

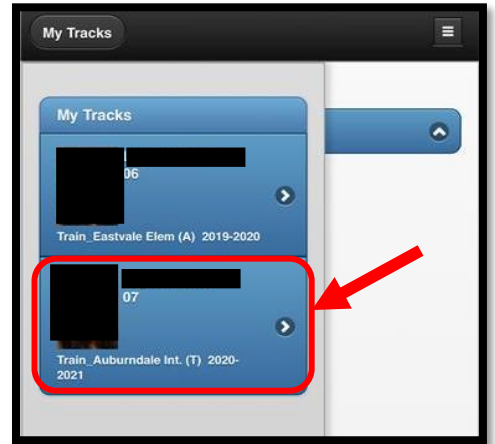
5) Select **SUBMIT**

**NOTE:** You can only remove course requests that you have added.

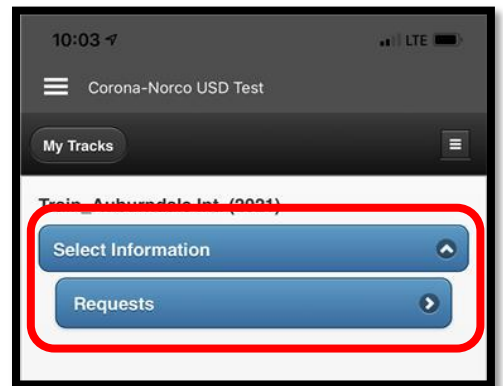


# HOW TO VIEW YOUR COURSE REQUESTS

1) Select the **FUTURE YEAR** track/enrollment line
