

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT HYBRID LEARNING...

1. **What do we do on our days home?** Your days home are still on the remote BLOCK schedule...so check your Google classrooms for the periods you are scheduled for that day (Mon/Wed 1,3,7,5; Tue/Thu 2,4,6,5). For your scheduled classes, do all assignments and check-ins, so that you will receive attendance credit. Expect assignments to take as long as an hour or more per class, depending on the task assigned. If you have any questions on the days you are home, check the Google Classroom for the office hours that your teacher has available between 10:10 and 11:45 am. They will have at least 45 minutes set aside so that you can contact them through Zoom or Google Meets remotely for an online meet-up. They will always be available to you daily.
2. **How are Friday's different?** Fridays are now office hours days, with an independent assignment. We have organized office hours so that you can meet with all teachers if you need to, according to the schedule of subjects. Check your Google classrooms and write down the Friday hours, so that you can get to who you need easily. It should be loosely based on this schedule, sent home last week:

FRIDAY for ALL STUDENTS – Remote Office Hours

Teacher will post office hours in Google Classroom, and work will be assigned Friday.

Office hours will be available by subject during or around the following times*, so student can access several different teachers during the day:

PE 8:00 am – 9:00 am

Math 8:30 – 9:30 am

Language Arts 9:00 – 10:00 am

History 9:30 – 10:30 am

Electives – 10:00 – 11:00 am

Science 10:30 am – 11:30 am

*Times will vary by teacher, and individual meetings can be scheduled this day. Students are encouraged to email teachers for extra assistance.

Students are not required to attend office hours on their "non-campus" days, but should expect assignments from each class. Attendance on Remote days is taken by daily, completed work and check-ins through Google Classroom.

3. **Are we required to attend office hours?** No, but we are required to be available to you daily, so you don't have to RSVP or let a teacher know you're coming...they will be there daily according to their posted schedule. If you get stuck in a meeting that hasn't been opened or can't find the office hours posted, please contact your teacher or our office for assistance.
4. **Do we need PE clothes? Where will we get them?** Right now, locker rooms are still closed to students. We recommend wearing comfortable shoes and clothing on PE days. When this changes, we will sell clothes on campus, for \$25.00 per set. If you do not want our set, your student may wear any black short and blue shirt, no pockets for safety. We also have sweatshirts for those chilly days! We hope to get you dressing out and working harder soon!
5. **Do I need to pay for the grab-and-go lunch?** No, not right now! Grab a lunch to take home...it has a breakfast product too! These are available at the end of the day outside the multi-purpose room as you leave campus!
6. **Do I need a district Chromebook?** Yes, we recommend this highly! While you CAN download the BYOD software to bring your own laptop/Chromebook, it is still a little slower connectivity. We also don't want you to drop or damage your personal device here at school. We have forms in the office for all students who don't yet have a district Chromebook. **Bring back the signed form and you will have the Chromebook on that day!** While it won't be used all day during live sessions (you've had enough of that at home!) a teacher may ask you to access an assignment for an editing conversation with a peer, or access another interactive program with your class, so it's good to have it with you.
